This letter will serve to confirm your official appointment to judge and your acceptance on the following terms and conditions to which both parties hereby agree:

1. The Committee of the

(Name of Affiliate)

will provide to you, **return economy / apex air fare / senior citizen** (advance purchase where applicable) from and to your place of residence.

2. Unless otherwise agreed:

(a) The Committee will provide you with a minimum of **three star accommodation** and meals for the period. The accommodation given to the Judges both overseas and Indian shall be one and the same.

(b) The Club shall pay the Judge a sum of **Rs.25,000/- as judging fees**. The judging fee of Rs.25,000/- per day must be paid on arrival before the show commences. It would be the duty of the Judge to sign a receipt for the judging fee received and shall not make any other claims.

(c) The Judges should be allowed to judge **only 225 dogs** and in the event of the entries being above 225 dogs, the respective club secretary's should decide about inviting a third judge or should the Club decide that the same judge could continue to judge more than 225 dogs **subject to the judge's confirmation** the judge should then be compensated by paying an extra judging fee of Rs.25,000/-. A maximum of 250 dogs (with extra judging fee) could be judged by a judge on a single day. If the number of dogs exceeded 250 then the additional dogs would necessarily have to be judged on an **extra day** and the judge compensated accordingly.

(d) The judging fee for a specialty shows will be Rs.15,000/- per specialty show.

3. The Judge shall **give an undertaking** that he / she will not accept to judge at more than **two pointed show** in the zone in a Show season.
4. Further in relation to air fares provided by the Club, the Judge **shall not accept any judging assignment** en-route to or from this assignment without the written consent of the Committee.
5. Once the Judge has accepted to judge and has executed the Judge's contract, it shall be the duty of the inviting club to **send the air ticket immediately**. Should this be an apex fare ticket, any cancellation of the judging assignment by virtue of the Judge being unable to undertake the assignment owing to unavoidable circumstances, it shall be the duty of the Judge to **inform the club** of his / her inability to come the moment it has been confirmed that he / she will not be able to fulfil the assignment owing to unavoidable and compelling reasons. If he / she fails to do so the club must be compensated with.
6. No Judge shall **cancel or withdraw** from judging at the last minute in order to accept another judging assignment either in India or overseas unless he / she has been released by the club and such release is obtained in writing.
7. **No Club shall terminate a Judge's contract** in order to accommodate some other Judge either from India or overseas unless the club has obtained the written consent of the Judge already contracted.
8. After signing the contract the club will be allowed to re-allocate the breed, group allocated to him / her only with the **mutual consent** of the club and the Judge.

As an acknowledgement of the acceptance of the terms and conditions, the Judge is required to sign, date and return the duplicate copies of this contract within 15 days from the date of receipt.
